



Protégé Auditions

Each student registered for the November convention will receive a number to wear during **ALL** convention classes. Numbers will be distributed before the first class on the first day **ONLY**. Students must be in every class to be eligible to audition for Protégé.

Students will be chose from the petite/junior, teen and senior rooms to audition for the Protégés to represent DMA Chapter #33 at the Winter Convention. There will be 10 Junior Protégés chosen from the petite/junior room. The Junior Protégés will receive a Protégé t-shirt or dance top and will be recognized onstage at the Winter Convention.

There will be 10 Senior Protégés chosen from the teen and senior rooms. The Senior Protégé dancers will perform at the opening of each competition event at the Winter Convention. The Overall Winners of the Junior and Senior DMA Scholarship auditions from the previous year are automatically Senior Protégés, making a total of 12 dancers. Rehearsals for the protégé dance will take place at the convention hotel on Thursday evening and Friday morning prior to the convention. All rehearsals are mandatory for participation. All students selected as Protégé dancers must be registered for the Winter Convention 2007. Protégé dancers must be students of a member teacher.

Please do not audition for the Protégés if you cannot be in attendance at the Winter 2007 Convention. We have had problems with this in the past so this year we will select a 1st and 2nd alternate from Teen/Senior classes. Those dancers will become Protégés in the event that a previously chosen Protégé cannot attend the convention.
