**COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION FORM BY MIDNIGHT OF DECEMBER 15, 2010  
for Group, Lines and Productions .**

1. Entry form-
  - a. Fill out form.
  - b. Use a separate entry form for each entry. Age divisions are determined by averaging the competitor's ages. Decimal points are to be dropped. **PLEASE DO NOT MAIL BIRTH CERTIFICATES!** You will need to have them available at the competition upon request. **Remember, birth dates are as of June 1<sup>st</sup> 2010.**

Make out check to **DMA Chapter #33**. Only DMA Teachers' checks will be accepted. Entry fee is \$20.00 per dancer for each entry...Groups, Lines and Productions. **DO NOT** send entries by certified mail. Use Delivery Confirmation **ONLY**.
  
3. Music- Teachers must email their music. **All music must be received by January 15<sup>th</sup>**. Send each piece of music in a separate file and in the body of the email include this information:
  - a. Name of Dance
  - b. Category (ballet, tap, jazz...)
  - c. Age (Petite, Junior...)
  - d. Division (Group, Line or Production)
  - e. Studio Code Letter

You have a separate deadline for this: January 15th. No longer will you be turning in your music at the grand body meeting.
