## **Guidelines for Application**

Revised August 2009

### **Applicants:**

- **Must be students of active members, in good standing of Dance Masters of America, Chapter 33**
- **Should be a current high school senior, or current college student**
- **Must have a grade point standing of 3.0 (high school) or higher, verified by an official transcript from student's high school and/or college**
- **Must complete and submit the attached application form**
- **Must submit an essay (500-1000 words) on how dancing has impacted your life, and what you seek to do with your talents in the future**
- **Must submit two letters of recommendation, one from a high school or college official, and a second from a dance instructor. These letters should accompany the application.**
- **Must include verification of acceptance to college, school or company**
- **Must be present at the Super Convention to receive the scholarship**
- **Will have a 3 to 5 minute interview with the Board approved panel of judges at the Super Convention**

**The DMA, Chapter 33 Annual Scholarship will be a one-time award of \$500 to a single individual each year.
